TO THE SCIENTIFIC SCHOOL “INDUSTRY4.0 – THE NEW INDUSTRY
REVOLUTION”**

THE CHAIRMAN OF DEPARTMENT

By considering that:

- the Department of Mechanical, Chemical and Materials Engineering has obtained funding by Sardegna Ricerche under the call “Scientific School 2016/2017” to organise a scientific school on ICT in industry, called Scientific School “Industry4.0 - The New Industry Revolution”;
- the scientific coordinator of the initiative is Pier Francesco Orrù, assistant professor of the SSD ING-IND / 17 (Industrial Engineering), employed in the above-mentioned department;

announces, for the Academic Year 2016/2017, the present call:

Art.1 - PURPOSE

This notice is aimed at selecting nr. 10 participants not enrolled at the University of Cagliari, in order to be admitted to the educational activities of the Scientific School “Industry4.0 - The New Industry Revolution”, which will be held in Pula (Cagliari District), at the Science and Technology Park “Polaris”, June 26-30, 2017. Nr. 5 positions with award assigned on the basis of assessable qualifications submitted by candidates, gross value € 400,00 (four hundred Euro) each, and nr. 5 positions without award will be available. Awards disbursement will take place after the initiative closure and it will be bound to frequency of 100% of activities included in the final program.

Art.2 - REQUIREMENTS

It is allowed to apply for this announcement by candidates not enrolled at University of Cagliari for the Academic Year 2016-2017 in undergraduate and / or postgraduate (postgraduate master's degrees, Ph.D. courses) courses, complying with the below indicated requirements by the deadline:

1. To be enrolled at an Italian University other than University of Cagliari, or at a foreign University in master's degree courses or equivalent degree programs as admitted by law, related to engineering topics;
2. to be enrolled in a doctoral program in engineering topics at an Italian University other than University of Cagliari, or at a foreign University.

Art.3 -APPLICATION SUBMISSION PROCEDURES

Candidates interested in participating to the Scientific School have to submit all the required documentation by **May 8, 2017, h.12:00 (Italian time)**, by one of the following ways:

- postal delivery to the following address: Secretariat of the Department of Mechanical, Chemical and Materials Engineering, Via Marengo n. 2 - 09123 Cagliari, Italy. The envelope must bear a label stating "*Iscrizione INDUSTRY4.0*";
- hand delivered to the following address: Secretariat of the Department of Mechanical, Chemical and Materials Engineering, Via Marengo n. 2 - 09123 Cagliari, Italy. The envelope must bear a label stating "*Iscrizione INDUSTRY4.0*";
- e-mail addressed to: segramm@dimcm.unica.it indicating the label "*Iscrizione INDUSTRY4.0*" in the object of the e-mail.

In any case, candidates whose applications will be received after the deadline, will not be eligible for selection. For applications sent by postal services, postmark serving will be not a proof, but applications will be considered only if the actual arrival of the application at the above indicated address will be by the deadline.

In the application form, candidates have to declare, under their own responsibility:

1. their genuine particulars, date and place of birth, address, contact details for the selection;
2. compliance with all the requirements as indicated in the Art. 2 of this announcement.



The application, to be filled according to the form available in the annex to this announcement (Annex A), candidates must enclose the following documents, produced in simple paper:

- 1) curriculum vitae;
- 2) photocopy of a valid identification document.

Information relating to this announcement and related forms are available on the website of the Department of Mechanical, Chemical and Materials Engineering of University of Cagliari, and it is also accessible on the event's website sites.unica.it/fir2017 and www.fir2017.it.

Art.4 – SELECTION PROCEDURE

The examination committee, composed by Associate Professor Francesco Floris, Assistant Professor Rita Ambu and Assistant Professor Pier Francesco Orrù, of the Department of Mechanical, Chemical and Materials Engineering of University of Cagliari, will draw up the final list of suitable candidates through assignment of scores related to the qualifications presented in CVs, to which a maximum total score of 100 points can be attributed.

It will be evaluated: graduations, PhD diplomas, postgraduate master's degrees, work experience as a research fellow or research scholar, scientific publications.

In case of equal merit, priority will be given to the youngest candidate.

Applicants will be informed on the outcome of the selection through publication of results on the event's website sites.unica.it/fir2017 and www.fir2017.it.

Art.5 – PARTICIPATION PROCEDURE

By 10 days from the date of publication of the final list, candidates admitted to the Scientific School will have to confirm their participation, by informing the administrative secretariat of the Department of Mechanical, Chemical and Materials Engineering of University of Cagliari, via Marengo n. 2 - 09123 Cagliari, Italy, and/or by e-mail addressed to pfrancesco.orrui@dimcm.unica.it.

Admitted candidates not complying with this requirement will be replaced by candidates further down the list.




If, for reasons related to the organisation of the School, more places will become available, the Administration will be able to call the suitable candidates according to the ranking list.
