

Report on PARTNER 7 – ITALY seminars for schools and citizens

Introduction:

Based on the WP4 outcomes and upon the requirements of WP5 Animation Tutorial, PP7 RAS conducted thirteen awareness seminars/events for eighteen schools in Cagliari, and one conference for the community. All the seminars were conducted in full cooperation with WP5 coordinator and TSC members.

Procedure:

Organization of Awareness raising campaigns in Sardinia

School Students involvement

Concerning the events with school students have been planned 10 seminars hosted by “Sardegna Ricerche”, a research center of the Region which has a laboratory where concrete examples of PV and other RES applications can be shown. The seminars consisted of a theoretical part in class, and a practical demonstration in laboratory. The first seminar has been held in November 2014 and the last in February 2015 (agenda attached). Concerning the speakers PP7 decided to use internal sources, TSC members and project manager as well as internal staff of Sardegna Ricerche that coordinated the laboratories.

Furthermore PP7 planned to take part with a stand at the “Cagliari Festival della Scienza” (Science festival) held in a municipal cultural center from the 4th to the 9th of November (2014) in order to involve schools, citizens and the academic world to discuss scientific issues through conferences, events, plays, study visits etc.

FOSTER in MED had a stand where have been distributed materials, shown presentations on pilot projects and discussed with students about the aim of the project. During these events also the students from the primary school have been involved. That is why in the attendance sheets there are not the signatures of the real number of participants. Furthermore many students had visited the stand in few minutes and even if the project staff asked for signature it was most of the time impossible to have the sheets signed due to lack of time and due to the fact that they had a fix path through the stands to be followed in a specific time.

Citizens involvement

During the Cagliari Festival della Scienza (Science festival) a final one day conference for citizens has been held the 8th of November focusing on the project activities (agenda attached).
