# **Scenario Analysis**

## in Urban and Regional Planning

Cagliari, June 25 - July 3, 2010

#### CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

#### What?

The International Summer Workshop on Scenario Analysis in Urban and Regional Planning is jointly organised by the University of Cagliari (UniCa) and the HafenCity University of Hamburg (HCU).

The workshop program includes a core multi-session training exercise on Scenario Analysis in Urban and Regional Planning for the students of the partner Universities, thematic seminars on spatial planning, and complementary scientific and socio-cultural activities fostering the exchange among participants.

The International Workshop official language is English.

#### Where / When? 25 June - 3 July 2010

The workshop will be held in Cagliari from June 25 - July 1, 2010 (Faculty of Architecture Room ALFA/BETA). On July 2-3, 2010 the Workshop will move to Baunei, for a visit at the Orosei Gulf natural area.

#### Why?

At the Workshop students will apply an innovative urban and regional planning collaborative decision-support technique. The students from UniCa and from HCU - which are partners in the LLP Erasmus Programme 2007/2013- will interact in the Workshop working in internationally mixed groups. In the Scenario Analysis exercise, they will exchange previous project or research experiences, and will share their interests and background skills in an international environment.

#### Who?

The Workshop participation is open to eight students from HCU (PhD, graduate, undergraduate levels), and up to twelve students from UniCA (i.e. up to three PhD, up to seven graduate, up to two undergraduate, or differently according to the applications). Exceptionally, the Selection Board may take a limited number of applications from third Universities into account.

#### How (to apply)?

UniCA students are eligible for application if they can demonstrate basic background in urban and regional planning and basic working knowledge of the English language. Applications (in English) should be sent by email to <a href="mailto:campagna@unica.it">campagna@unica.it</a>, including full details of the current student status, a motivation letter, and a complete Curriculum Vitae (CV) in Europass format (including reference to completed courses in disciplines related to urban and regional planning). Applications will be evaluated by the Workshop Chairpersons according to the following criteria: I) CV; II) Motivation; III) Knowledge of the English language; IV) Gender balance; V) First come, first served in case of equal score.

If deemed appropriate by the Selection Board, applicants may be invited for a brief interview.

All the decisions of the Selection Board are final. Incomplete applications will be not considered for evaluation.

#### Deadline for applications is Tuesday 18 May, 2010, H.12.00.

Applicants will be informed by email on the results of the selection process.

The participation is free of charge for all students. Selected participants are expected to cover their personal transport, meals and lodging expenses related to the Workshop participation (i.e. the excursion to Baunei). Admitted participants should expect full-time involvement in the Workshop from June 23 to July 3, 2010.

A certificate of attendance will be given to all participants who will successfully complete the Workshop Program.
